## Tuesday Jackpot Bowls

Time: Register by 12.30 pm - Cards called at 1 pm
Entry Fee is $\$ 10$, all of which goes towards the Jackpot.
Pairs will be played unless there are insufficient players for an additional pairs game, then a triples game will be played. It is up to the players on each rink to choose if they play $2,2,2,2$ or $2,4,2$ when playing a pairs game or to play 2 or 3 bowls when playing a triples game.

No roll ups. No dead ends (Jack to be re-spotted on the T). At the start of each end, if the Jack is thrown into the ditch, out over either side or too short, then the opposing skip should place the Jack anywhere they want and not throw it back.

Although no particular number of ends has to be played, 18 at least is suggested, but all games should be finished by 4 pm .

If there are less than 8 players in attendance, players may have a game, but no entry fees will be collected \& the Jackpot will not be drawn.

Jackpot numbers will be the winning/losing margin on each rink. Should there be a winner, the Jackpot will be shared equally among the four or six players on that respective rink. Should two or more rinks end up with the same margin, then the Jackpot will be shared equally among all the players on those rinks.

The numbers put into the number generating machine will be from 0-21. Should any rinks have a margin higher than 21, the highest margin over 21 will be allocated 21, the second highest will be allocated 20 and so on.

The Jackpot will accumulate each week until won. One number will be drawn each week until the Jackpot amount reaches $\$ 1000$. Then a second number will be drawn if the first number drawn is not a winning number. If the second number drawn is a winning number, then the winning players will share half of the Jackpot amount. A third number will be drawn should the Jackpot reach $\$ 1500$ for a third of the Jackpot amount, and a fourth number will be drawn at $\$ 2000$ for a quarter of the Jackpot amount etc. An additional draw will continue to be added for each additional $\$ 500$ in the Jackpot. In any case, once a winning number has been drawn, there will be no further numbers drawn on that day.
